Let's Talk About Mental Health

We are excited to welcome Dawn Handley, President of Speak Up, as our guest speaker at this week's meeting.

Speak Up was founded as a way to create a meaningful legacy for Dawn's oldest son, Scott who struggled with a mental health condition for 10 years before dying by suicide in 2020. Our mission is to remove the stigma of mental illness along with providing unique programs and projects to educate others on mental health, mental illness and suicide awareness, with a focus on youth. We work with many different neighborhood family centers, art centers, youth in foster care, schools, and law enforcement. We also host community events in which we bring in many of the resources in our neighborhoods that residents are not aware of along with providing youth activities, free books, produce and many other giveaways.

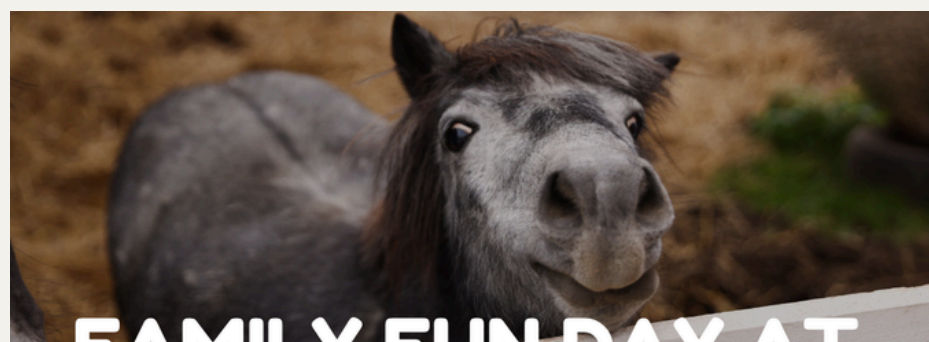
